Best results are obtained by thoroughly wetting leaf surface with spray solution, and applying when weeds and grasses are actively growing.

#### When to Apply

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#### Directions for Use

### FOR FLOWERBED AND GARDEN PREPARATION, AND FOR LAWN REPLACEMENT

#### How to Mix

Pump-Up Sprayers (tank type hand-held and backpack)
Best for spot spraying or small area treatment.

Add: 21/2 fl. oz. (5 Tbs.) to 1 gallon of water 5 fl. oz. (10 Tbs.) to 2 gallons of water 71/2 fl. oz. (15 Tbs.) to 3 gallons of water

Spray each gallon of spray solution evenly over 300 sq. ft. or spot spray individual weeds.

#### **Hose-End Sprayer**

Best for large area treatment and lawn renovation.

**Regular**: Add 8 fl. oz. to sprayer jar for every 1,000 sq. ft. to be treated.

Apply evenly over area.

Dial Type: Set dial to 21/2 oz. or 5 Tbs., whichever applies. Add Preen®

Weed & Grass Killer to jar. (Do not add water!) Apply evenly over

area to be treated.

#### How to Apply

IMPORTANT: Preen® Weed & Grass Killer will kill most types of plants and grasses. SPRAY ONLY THOSE WEEDS AND GRASSES YOU WANT TO CONTROL.

Spray weeds and grasses until thoroughly wet.

When spot spraying around desirable plants and ornamentals use a directed spray. If desirable plants are sprayed, rinse off immediately. Preen® Weed & Grass Killer is not recommended for spot spraying in lawns.
